### COL. TIM DONNELLAN

#### Commander of the 124<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing at Gowen Field

Col. Donnellan assumed command at Gowen Field in January 2015. He is a decorated Combat Veteran A-10 "Thunderbolt II" fighter pilot. His military career includes five combat deployments. Among his major awards and decorations are: Air Medal, Distinguished Flying Cross, Meritorious Service Medal, Aerial Achievement Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal, and Air Force Combat Action Medal. Col. Donnellan graduated from Purdue University in 1990 where he received his commission as Second Lieutenant.



### REBECCA HUPP

#### Director of Boise Airport

Rebecca Hupp has been the Airport Director at the Boise Airport since April of 2012. She previously served as the Director at Bangor International Airport in Maine from 2001-2012 and Airport Manager of the Aberdeen Regional Airport in South Dakota. Hupp earned a B.S. in Aviation Management from the Florida Institute of Technology and an MBA from Webster University. She is responsible for the day-to-day operations and long-term planning and development of the Boise Airport.



### MEGAN RONK

#### Director at Idaho Department of Commerce

Megan Ronk is the first woman to lead the Idaho Department of Commerce, previously holding the Chief Operating Officer and Public Information Officer position. Before her work at the Department of Commerce, Ronk was executive director of the Idaho Meth Project, a strategic projects manager for Blue Cross of Idaho, and a policy adviser to Governor Dirk Kempthorne. She earned a B.A. in Business Administration from the University of Idaho and an MBA from the Thunderbird School of Global Management.
