Dear Fred:

This letter is to provide you with 30 days notice of intended action by Capital City Development Corporation (CCDC) to implement several parking rate and operational changes in the Civic Plaza Corridor. A final decision will be made by the CCDC Board.

As you know from recent correspondence, the CCDC Board set the hourly rate in CCDC facilities at \$2.50/hour, effective August 1, 2008. CCDC intends to apply this rate to the following parking activities currently utilized by the County effective Monday, April 20, 2009:

- Parking validation (stickers) will increase from \$0.75/hour to the full rate of \$2.50/hour. Existing validation in circulation will be honored until any existing supply is exhausted to avoid accounting inconveniences. If any more validation is needed between now and April 20, 2009, sales will be limited to the historical volume purchased over the past year.
- Law enforcement parking will increase from \$1.00/hour to the full rate of \$2.50/hour. CCDC has taken steps to notify all other law enforcement agencies of this change. Beginning April 20, 2009, CCDC will bill the law enforcement agencies for actual hours used times the full rate of \$2.50. Please let CCDC know by April 15, 2009, whether you prefer to continue the current billing protocol for validation program at the \$2.50 rate. If CCDC does not receive written confirmation by April 15, please be advised that the officers will be individually charged \$2.50 per hour upon exiting CCDC parking facilities.
- Juror parking will increase from \$0.75/hour to the full rate of \$2.50/hour. Beginning April 20, 2009, CCDC (or its parking operator) will bill the jury commissioner's office for actual hours used times the full rate of \$2.50. Please let CCDC know by April 15, 2009, whether you prefer to continue the current billing protocol for the validation program at the \$2.50 rate. If CCDC does not receive written confirmation by April 15, please be advised that the jurors will be individually charged \$2.50 per hour upon exiting CCDC parking facilities.



- The practice of a free “10 minute drop off/pick up” will cease.

If you have any questions, CCDC staff would be happy to address them. Also, should you wish to address the CCDC Board, please be advised the CCDC Board will next meet on Monday, April 13, 2009, at noon at the CCDC office. If you would prefer to submit written comment, CCDC will distribute such written comment.
