Re: "Take a knee."

Dear Mr. Goodell,

I write as one of the vast, uncounted NFL fans to say only that henceforward I will be boycotting all matters associated with the NFL and now, likely, professional sports in general. Sports is a game that is now being "gamed" by the players with the apparent full support of the NFL, and soon, I suspect, other leagues, despite their own rules. The specific rule pertaining to the national anthem is found on pages A62-63 of the NFL league rulebook, which states: "The National Anthem must be played prior to every NFL game, and all players must be on the sideline for the National Anthem. During the National Anthem, players on the field and bench area should stand at attention, face the flag, hold helmets in their left hand, and refrain from talking."
